## Theme of the Day

2017 marks two significant anniversaries: the 500th anniversary of Luther's posting of the 95 Theses and the 75th anniversary of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League. Since 1942, the LWML has affirmed each woman's identity as a child of God and her relationship with Jesus Christ, encouraged and equipped Christian women to live out their lives in active mission ministries, and supported missions around the world through their sacrificial gifts of mites, tithes, offerings, and tireless service. Now is our time to "Be Ready to Confess!" faithfully and boldly of Christ's redemptive work for us and for all the world. Today we continue with our BELIEVE Series and Chapter Three – Salvation. So, what do you Believe? Do you believe God is good? Do you believe He is involved in and cares about your daily life? If the answer is yes, then live each day as though it's true. Ponder the difference this can make in your life. While many things in the Bible are difficult to understand salvation is not one of them. **LWML SUNDAY:** Today we celebrate the LWML (Lutheran Women's Missionary League) that for 75 years has been touching lives all over the world. First, thank you Zion for your support of our projects. We couldn't do them without your help.

Please join us today during the Bible Study Hour and hear from three of the local Missions that Zion's LWML supports: Alpha Center, St. Francis House and Children's Inn. We will be serving muffins/coffee cake today and all donations will be given to these three Ministries, so please give generously.

You've probably heard a lot of talk about **Mites**. Every month we collect 'Mites' and send them on to the District LWML that keeps 75% and sends 25% on to the National LWML. Over the past 75 years the National LWML has given away over **\$100 million** for Mission Projects ... that's a lot of Mites!!
