WHAT IS A SPIRITUAL GIFT? Definition: A spiritual gift is a special attribute given by the Holy Spirit to every member of the Body of Christ, according to God's grace, for use within the context of the Body. Spiritual gifts are given with a purpose. God wants to redeem this broken world, and He has chosen to use us, the church, to do it. Whereas in the Old Testament the Holy Spirit temporarily came upon followers of God to enable them to fulfill specific tasks, the New Testament clearly indicates that the Holy Spirit dwells in all believers and that all believers have spiritual gifts. And since the New Testament refers to specific gifts, it seems safe to assume that God wants us to identify our gifts in order to best use them.

Key Idea: I know my spiritual gifts and use them to fulfill God's purposes.
