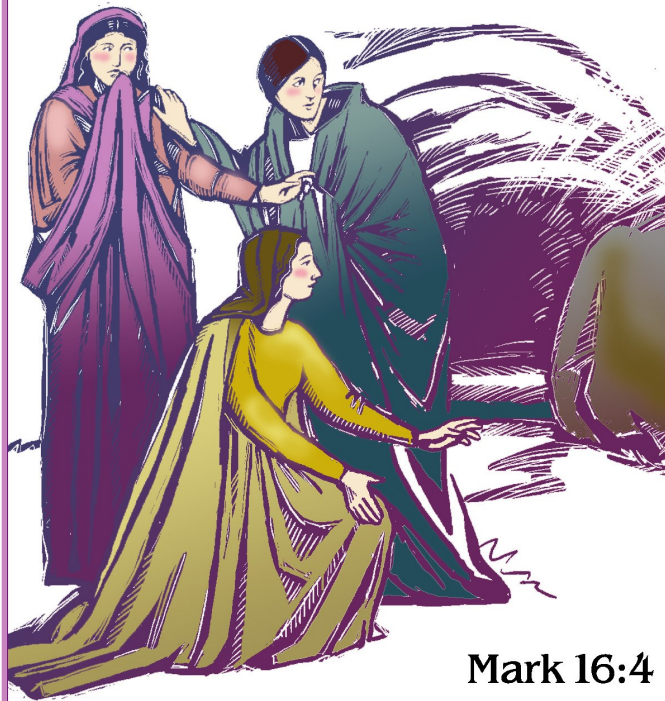

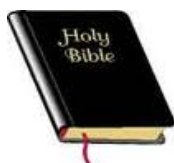
Kids Crossing: Miss Susan, the church Librarian, uses different eggs to illustrate the Easter story. She then reads the real story.
