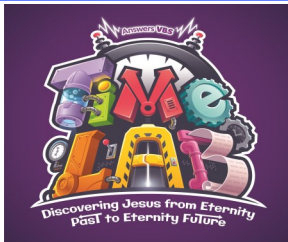

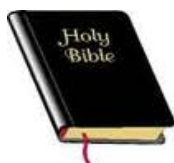
Kids Crossing: Miss Lisa and Lilly discuss how the nicest and fanciest things on earth cannot be compared to the majesty of Heaven.
