## Theme of the Day

When Christ saves us and we are grafted into His vine and ushered into His Kingdom, the Spirit of God, the presence of God, comes to live within our hearts. He is now the center of our lives. Every thought, action and virtue produced from our renewed and redeemed mind and heart is born from and empowered by the very presence of God. We begin by thinking like Jesus ... with believing like Jesus. These central beliefs have unified and empowered the church over the centuries. So over the course of the next 10 chapters or 10 weeks we'll focus on the top ten key beliefs of the Christian life. Within each topic, we will address three areas: 1. Key Question – What life question does this belief answer? 2. Key Idea - What is the unifying concept of this belief that Christians ... we embrace? 3. Key Application - What difference does this make in the way I live? Your goal is to read each belief and to understand it. Once you do, ask yourself if you then also believe ... do you take this truth down deep into your heart? If the answer is yes ... the remaining step is to live it from the power source of God's presence in your life.
