

Theme of the Day

The Passover meal in Exodus 12:1-14 continues to this day as a central festival for the Jewish tradition. The meal, however, also has meaning for Christians as background and resource for the Christian ritual meal of Holy Communion. Many of Passover's elements and themes clearly carry over into the Lord's Supper. The Synoptic Gospels all testify that Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper as part of his Jewish celebration of the Passover meal "on the night in which He was betrayed" (Matthew 26:17-29; Mark 14:12-25; Luke 22:7-23) with His Jewish disciples. Just as the Passover story defined the core meanings of the ritual meal of Passover, so the story of Jesus' death and resurrection defines the core meanings of the Lord's Supper. Ritual and narrative work together as mutually interpretive. Many other elements in the complex set of images and themes attached to Passover spill over and inform the complex meanings and images of Holy Communion.

THE LWML MITE BOX



Based on the Biblical account of the widow's mite (Luke 21:1-4), the Mite Box is intended for regular contributions of "mites" — offerings above and beyond the support given to congregations and the LCMS. Mite Box contributions amount to millions of dollars that fund District and National Mission Grants and implement the LWML program.

Mite Boxes are distributed to every woman in LWML, and often to members of the congregation.

LWML ladies were reminded not to just tuck their Mite Box away out of sight and then on the day of a Circle meeting take out a dollar bill, put it in an envelope and hand it to the secretary. The following suggestions offered were:

- * Put your pennies in the box at the end of each day
- * Say "thank you" with an appropriate amount whenever calamity or misfortune has been averted
- * Empty all your loose change from your kitchen coin bowl into the box on meeting day

Throughout the decades, Lutheran women have stepped out in faith, setting goals and trusting God to move the hearts of His people to give generously to LWML to proclaim the Gospel.

The 2017–2019 LWML Mission Goal is: \$2,075,000.00 but as of February 14, they are \$211,547.20 short of meeting their goal. The fiscal year ends March 31.

Some of the Grants yet to be paid are: Lutheran Heritage Foundation; Christian Families United for Progress; LWR Quilt and Kit Shipping Fund; Training Lutheran Middle Eastern Missionaries; Lutherans for Life; Lutheran Braille Workers; Lutheran Indian Ministries; Evangelical Lutheran Church of Liberia; Ministry Focus; LCMS Office of International Mission.

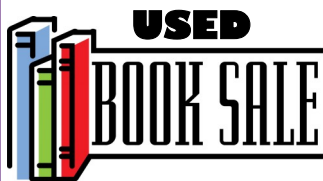

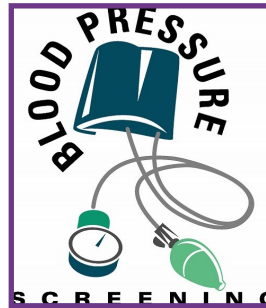

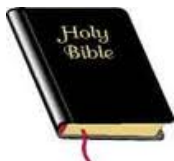
