March 13—"The Mount of Temptation"

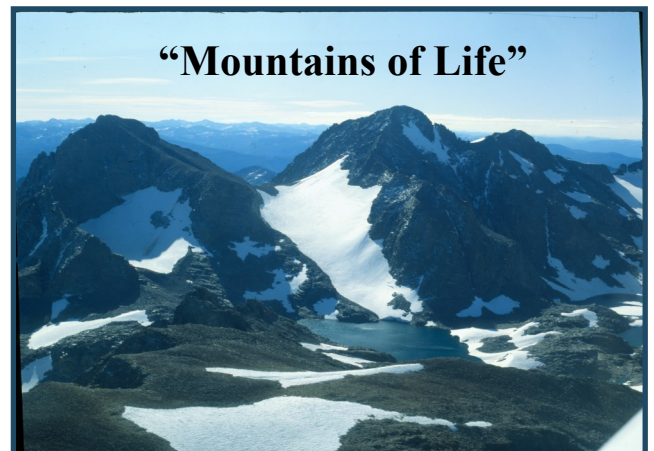
March 20—"The Mount of Suffering"

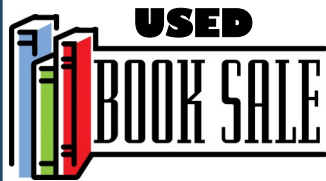
