**TEAM ZION** .... It's that time AGAIN!!!

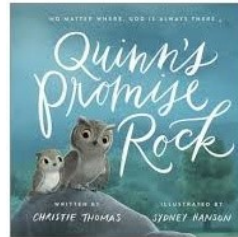
