Main Street Living Media Ministry Sunday

In 2002, Main Street Living started out small, but God had bigger things in mind. Main Street Living (MSL), is the televised worship service you are helping to make available to our region. It began in Sioux Falls on the local NBC network affiliate. Now, 17 years later, it is being aired on eight TV stations in a five-state area. The growth of MSL is a pleasant surprise to us, but it's no surprise to our God, who richly blesses!

- ▶ What has God done? He has allowed us to air modified worship services, with Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) pastors bringing us God's Word, using the appointed Scripture readings for the church year.
- ▶ He has allowed MSL to be locally produced, not only utilizing pastors from the respective broadcast areas, but also the talents of laypeople who tape and produce the shows. In some of our broadcast areas, local LCMS members have formed MSL choirs to tape the hymns for the broadcasts.
- ▶ The program is regionally recognized – in the South Dakota, North Dakota, Minnesota North, Minnesota South, Iowa West, and Nebraska Districts of our Synod.
- ▶ While the program is viewed by thousands of homebound people, recent information also indicates the program is becoming popular with non-Lutherans and others who are not attending services in their local congregations. Therefore, this ministry might be the only connection some people have to the saving grace of Jesus!
- ▶ God has enabled our ministry to bring His Good News far beyond the upper Great Plains; MSL is a ministry for the world, via our website and Facebook presence.

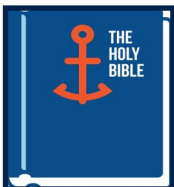
This is the Life: NO program next week.
